# Can you or someone you know benefit from physical, speech or occupational therapy?

Medical rehabilitation focuses primarily on the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of injuries and disabilities to help children and adults enhance or restore the function necessary to continue to be as independently as possible in everyday activities. This enables participation in education, work, play, and meaningful life roles.

***A person may be in need of physical, occupational, or speech therapy following an injury, surgery, disease or illness, or because their functioning has declined with age. Diagnoses can include Multiple Sclerosis, stroke, Alzheimer's Disease, Parkinson's Disease, Intellectual/Developmental Disability or Traumatic Brain Injury, among others.***

## Screening for Physical Therapy

Physical therapy focuses on improving strength, balance, coordination and mobility.

**If a person experiencing any of the following problems, they might benefit from a physical therapy evaluation:**

- Recently lost the ability to do things s/he used to do, such as dressing or bathing
- Recently experienced a fall either in the home or center
- Uses a wheelchair and either complains of being uncomfortable or looks uncomfortable
- Has an unsteady gait, loses their balance while walking and/or has to hold onto furniture or other supports while walking
- Has trouble getting in and out of bed, on and off the toilet and/or in and out of a car
- Has trouble walking the distance necessary to get from the car to an activity/living area or from the activity/living area to the bathroom without becoming winded or fatigued
- The caregiver has trouble lifting the person or transferring the person in and out of the car, bath or bed
- Redness of the skin is observed when bathing or toileting, especially if the person uses a wheelchair or is bed bound

## Screening for Occupational Therapy

Occupational therapy focuses on improving self-care skills, eye-hand coordination, home safety, strength and endurance.

**If a person or caregiver experiencing any of the following problems, they might benefit from a occupational therapy evaluation:**

- Recently lost the ability to do things s/he used to do, such as dressing or bathing
- Experiencing problems writing, holding a cup or using silverware, such as frequently drops or spills items or has trouble holding them
- Loses track of or forgets medication doses
- Has concerns about home safety, for instance leaving the stove on, the refrigerator open, tripping on rugs, slips and falls.
- Experiences difficulty with or has less interest in maintaining personal hygiene and/or grooming.
- Caregiver is experiencing increasing difficulty providing personal care such as dressing, feeding, bathing and hygiene.

## Screening for Speech and Language Pathology

Speech language pathology can enhance or restore a person's ability to communicate through speech and other means and it helps with identifying and resolving problems related to swallowing.

**If a person experiencing any of the following problems, they might benefit from a speech language pathology evaluation:**

### Language

- Is not talking as much as before, words seem jumbled or garbled and/or has lost interest in reading
- Can't think of the right word or uses the wrong word in sentences
- Does not seem to understand what other people are saying
- Family members report increased difficulty understanding what is being said

### Swallowing

- Chokes, coughs, gags or clears throat frequently when eating
- Food dribbles out of the mouth or is pocketed in the cheeks
- Drooling, either during eating or even when not eating
- Frequent respiratory problems, such as pneumonia
