From the CEO...

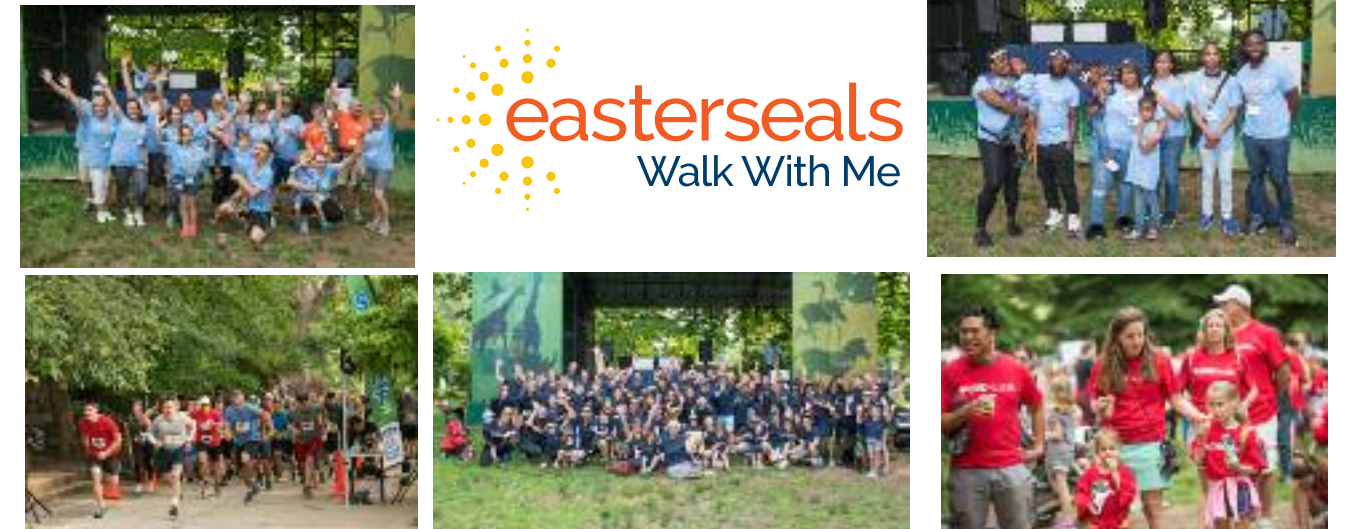
